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Basic travel information

Accommodation

The Youth Hostel Flensburg is located in Flensburg.

Flensburg is located at the end of the Flensburg Fjord, about 5 kilometers south of the Danish border and only 70 kilometers from Kiel, the capitol city of Schleswig-Holstein.

Arrival

When planning your itinerary, please bear in mind that you should arrive latest at 16:00 on 24 August, because departure to the site of the welcome meeting will be at 17:45.



It is possible to arrive early, should you need to due to available flight connections.

The closest airports are Hamburg (HAM) in Germany und Billund (BLL) in Denmark.

From Hamburg airport you can take a tram (Line S1 in the direction of Wedel (Holst)) to the main station in Hamburg. From there, take the RE7 train to Flensburg central station.

At the airport Billund you can take a bus that goes to Kolding and from there trains go to the Flensburg central station.

Departure

Teams and guests should depart after checkout on Monday, 27 August at 10:00 h. Return flights should leave no earlier than at 14:00 h.

Shuttle-Service

The hosts will organize shuttle services from the central station in Flensburg to the Youth Hostel. Please enter your exact arrival/departure times into the registration forms or, should you have lost your edit link, please inform the SAM.I. GS about the exact times and flight number.

Meals

During the event, all people who registered will be able to take their meals directly at the Youth Hostel.



Clothing

In the region where the Contest will take place, changeable weather and temperatures around 20°C are normal in August. We ask the participants to check the weather report before departure and to pack appropriate clothing. We recommend clothes for warm temperatures as well as clothes for cooler days

During the competition, every team must wear the **uniform/t-shirt of their own association**. **Sturdy shoes** are strongly recommended. We also recommend **wearing a hat to prevent possible heatstroke**.

Health and Safety

Of course, we hope that everyone will endure/experience the weekend safe and sound.



However, everybody is responsible for the availability of any necessary medication themselves! Please also do not forget to bring your European Health Insurance Card – EHIC (in some EU member states, it is printed on the back of your regular health insurance card). Should participants not have a European Health Insurance Card, we kindly ask them to sign up for travel health insurance for the duration

of the contest. Any necessary medications are to bring on your own.

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Contest

ASB und Dansk Folkehjælp will do their best to ensure that all participants will return home with many positive memories and new friendships. Just as it was at the past Contests, there will be a theoretical test on first aid, the practical part of the Contest, a creative part and final evening event, for which everyone is called upon to actively participate.

The details on the theoretical first aid test and the practical part will be announced on August 24, during the welcome meeting. The first aid kits and any other necessary materials will be distributed in Flensburg.

Creative part

The members of the groups from each organization (groups A and B together), prepare a short stage play, which has the motto:

PIRATES OF THE BALTIC SEA

The stage performance should last a maximum of 5 minutes and be understandable for all participants and guests without any translation. For detailed information, please see the enclosed overview document for the creative part.

First Aid competition

Saturday, 25. August

All teams of group A will write the test from 10:00 h to 11:30 h.

The teams of group B will write the test from 15:30 h to 17:00 h.

First Aid Tasks – Starting times and places

There will be a timetable on site/at the Youth Hostel and the teams will be shuttled to the start of the city game/first aid tasks rally.

Sightseeing information for Sønderborg

At the History Centre Dybbøl Banke you will dive right into the events of the dramatic war of 1864. You will get involved in one of the most exciting chapters of Danish history. Experience history with all your senses: As you enter the territory, you will hear the cannon thunder mingling with the screaming and weeping of the wounded soldiers. Have a look into the barracks in the soldiers' camp behind the front, where the young and tired soldiers try to find some peace between the bloody battles. In the soldiers' camp you can see how the soldiers cooked and slept. Furthermore you can study their weapons and equipment and some of you will be able to try on a uniform. A blacksmith will help you to throw an iron bullet, in a shed you will be able to make a pancake over an open fire and you can also send a telegram and write a letter in ink.

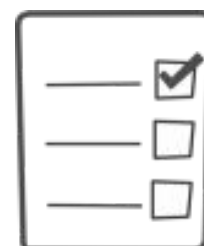
